About Our Services

Community-Based Palliative Care provides compassionate care and services. We focus on quality of life and goals of care.

- You can continue to receive treatment for your serious illness while you receive palliative care services.
- You can receive palliative care services when a cure for your serious illness is possible.
- You do not need to be confined to your home to receive palliative care.
- You can receive our services at the same time as you get home care and other types of community services.

We help you and your family as you make difficult decisions about your care. We provide education, support and counsel to guide you in this process.

Our team may include a nurse, social worker, spiritual counselor, doctor and nurse practitioner. We work with your primary care team to ensure you receive the support you need.

As part of our services, our team works with you to create health care directive. A health care directive identifies health care wishes and a person (also known as a health care agent) who can make health care decisions for you if you are not able to make them.

Special services

- Home visit by the palliative care team
- Help with advance care planning, setting goals of care and completing a health care directive
- Supportive counseling to address your emotional and spiritual needs
- Regular coordination and communication with your primary care physician and other care team members to ensure
 - » continuity of care
 - » management of your pain and symptoms
- Education and information about your serious illness
- Discussion about benefits and burdens of possible treatments

Insurance
